The public launching of the website ([www.16000voices.org.nz](http://www.16000voices.org.nz)) was on Wednesday, March 8th.

Dr Silloway-Smith explains: "Most of the NZ public is unaware of just how overwhelming the opposition has been to the introduction of euthanasia legislation.

"For nearly seven months, the Health Select Committee has been hearing stories from hundreds of Kiwis and three out of four of them have been saying no to euthanasia. But hardly anyone outside of the Committee is aware of what they've said.

"If the Committee reports accurately on what they've been reading and hearing, we're unlikely to see an endorsement for euthanasia legislation, which may come as a shock to many. That's why 16,000 voices is so important – to let us hear why Kiwis are saying no to euthanasia in their own words."
