

## PROLIFE FACTS

A bill to allow abortion up to birth for any reason, was defeated last week in the New South Wales state parliament by 25 votes to 14. Green MP Mehreen Faruqi's bill galvanised abortion-rights advocates and pro-lifers. In two weeks, 56,559 people opposed to the bill, signed an official parliamentary petition, calling on NSW politicians to reject both the Faruqi bill and another pro-abortion bill proposed by a Labour MP Penny Sharpe. NSW and Queensland are now the only two Australian states to keep abortion under the Criminal Code. A similar bill in Queensland was defeated earlier this year after a massive pro-life campaign.

Lifesite News reported that independent polling released by Galaxy Research showed that so much of mainstream media coverage is completely removed from what people actually think about abortion. Just 5% wanted abortion legalised up to birth.

There was a Kiwi connection to the Women's Forum Australia opposing Faruqi's bill. Its director of research, policy and advocacy is Rachael Wong, a lawyer who was a member of Pro-Life Auckland at university and one of the first graduates of the Internship in Kapiti to train pro-life activists.
