Right To Life has recently started an online petition on the CitizenGo website, addressed to the Ministers of Health, Justice and Women, asking that the government ensure that the laws relating to abortion are upheld and due consideration is given to the rights of the unborn child. The petition comes at a time when there is increasing pressure for complete decriminalisation of abortion, which is likely to lead to even greater numbers of abortion deaths. The petition also asks that government ensure that the conscience rights of health professionals are upheld, so that no person is forced to be involved with any part of an abortion death.
