Simon O'Connor MP



Simon is currently the Chair of the Foreign Affairs, Defence, and Trade Committee. He has also been appointed as the National Party's Spokesperson on Customs. He is also the party's associate spokesperson for housing and social development. In the previous Parliament, he was the Chair of the Health Committee.

Simon was first elected as the Member of Parliament for Tamaki in 2011, and is now serving this third term in Parliament. Prior to his election, his background included a broad range of experiences from the commercial, public, and voluntary sectors.

Simon was educated at the University of Auckland and earned several degrees there, most recently, a Masters of Political Studies in 2010, which he undertook while working full-time.

Between 1995 and 2004, Simon trained to become a Catholic priest. Though he completed his training,

he did not seek ordination. Instead, he sought wider involvement in the community to make a practical, hands-on difference.
